Dear Summer Camp Travelers,

This is a welcome e-mail for the Travelers Camp! We are so excited to start our Bi Lingual Factory Of Fun Summer Camp!

Here is some useful and important information for the Camp:

Calendar: Summer Travelers Camp starts on June 12th and is a daily program from 8:00am until 4:00 pm. Our program includes Lunch, Snacks, and all the amazing activities included in the attached calendar!

### **Days we will be closed (No School or Camp)**

July 4th in observance of Independence Day

July 29th for Teacher Planning Day

August 5th for Teacher Planning Day

### **What to wear:**

We understand that children need to be in comfortable clothes, appropriate for outdoor activities. For their safety, sandals, flip-flops, jellies, or boots may not be worn to Camp. We recommend that all children wear sneakers or strapped up water shoes. To foster independence, we encourage parents to use clothing that children can easily manipulate.

Yellow Summer Camp T-Shirt is mandatory for all travelers! They must wear it every day!

For Swimming Days (Mondays and Wednesdays): Children arrive dressed in Yellow Summer Camp t-shirt and swimwear. They should also pack a towel, extra shorts/underwear to change into and an empty plastic bag for wet swimwear/towel. For girls, preferably use one piece bathing suits, as it is more comfortable for swimming lessons. Swimming Cap is not necessary, but can be packed if preferred.

For Soccer Days (Tuesdays): Yellow Summer Camp T-shirt. Also, children need to wear sneakers (any kind).

For Field Trip Days (Thursdays): Yellow Summer Camp T-Shirt. If any special wear is needed, we will inform the week of the Field Trip.

For Movie Days (Fridays): Yellow Summer Camp uniform and comfortable clothing for movie goers and also play at the park.



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### **What to Pack?**

Children should bring a re-usable, spill-proof water bottle. Extra snacks from home are allowed, always peanut-free and healthy, and taking into consideration that they will need to be outdoor friendly snacks (no snacks that can easily melt or spoil outdoors) If you need ideas for snacks, please feel free to ask us!

Sunblock must be applied every morning at home and each child should bring an extra bottle of Sunblock to keep in the Summer Camp van. Bottle should be labeled with Sharpie.

Caps, hats and sunglasses must also be labeled properly.
